***Fast track** your rail freight*

Context: regulation 913/2010

Article 18 Information on the conditions of use of the freight corridors

The management board shall draw up, regularly update and publish a document containing:

(b) The list and characteristics of terminals, in particular information concerning the conditions and methods of accessing the terminals

Request from RFC2

- Following the last TAG meeting, it was agreed that:
 - RFC1 & RFC2 send common templates to all terminals
 - The terminal fills in the relevant templates (dry bulk, liquid bulk, general cargo, intermodal & marshalling yards) and then publishes them on their website
 - The terminal provides the corridor(s) with the link to the webpages where the templates are located
 - The corridor(s) publishes this link in the Corridor Information Document (book III)
 - When the terminal changes the data and/or the link, it immediately informs the corridor(s) about the change
- This process is supported by the Executive boards of both corridors (letter dated 30 May 2013 sent to all terminals/ports)

Timeline

- A mail was sent to terminals on 17 September (RFC1 & RFC2 terminals) and 2/3 October (RFC2 terminals only)
- When a terminal is located in a port, the mail was only sent to the port. The port was asked to distribute the templates to each corridor terminal within the port
- The links to the templates are requested for the 27 September or 11 October in order for RFC1/RFC2 to have sufficient time to publish them on their website before 10 November 2013
