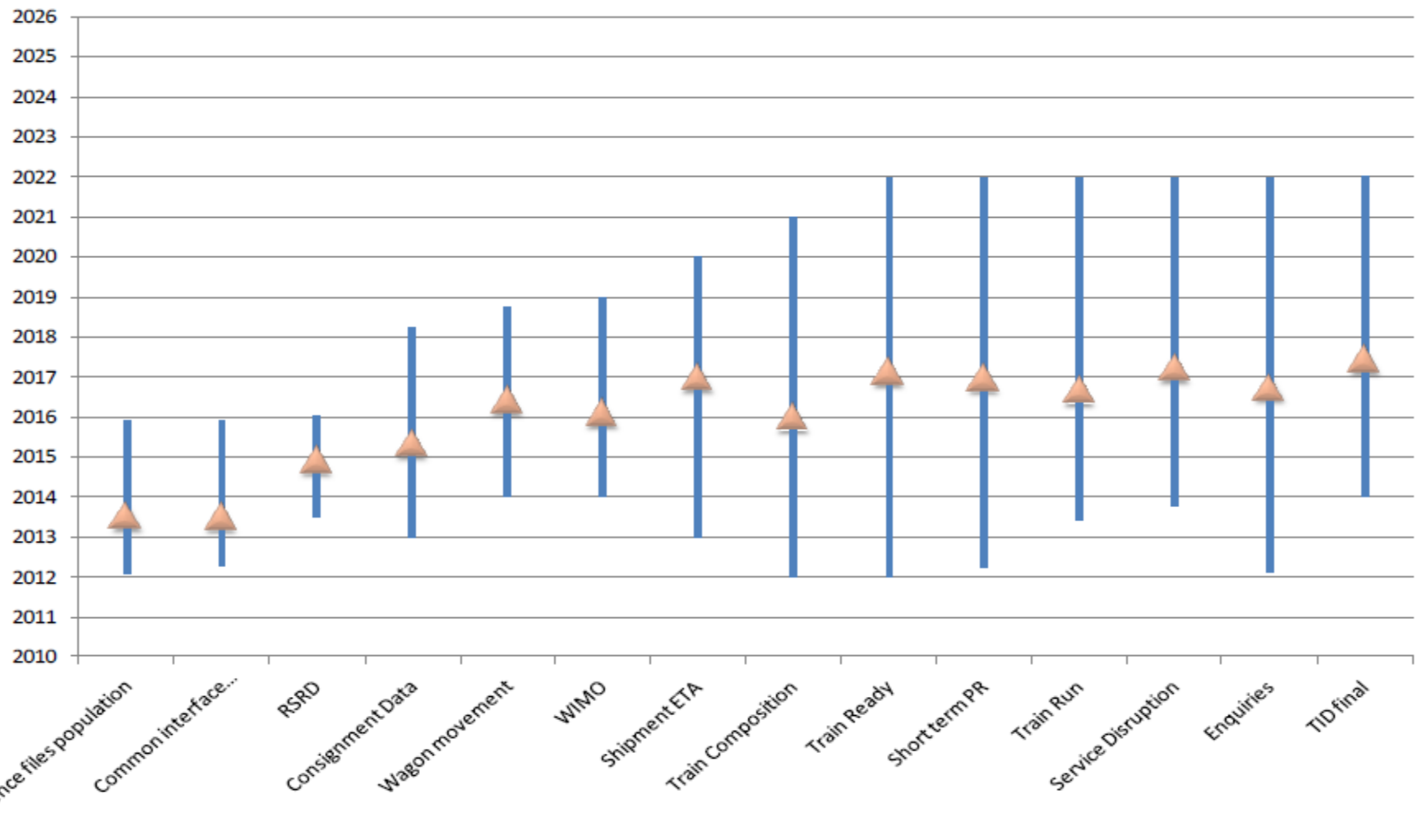
*TAF TSI sets the mandatory functional and technical specifications for exchanging data with an harmonised format between infrastructure managers, railway undertakings and other stakeholders.*

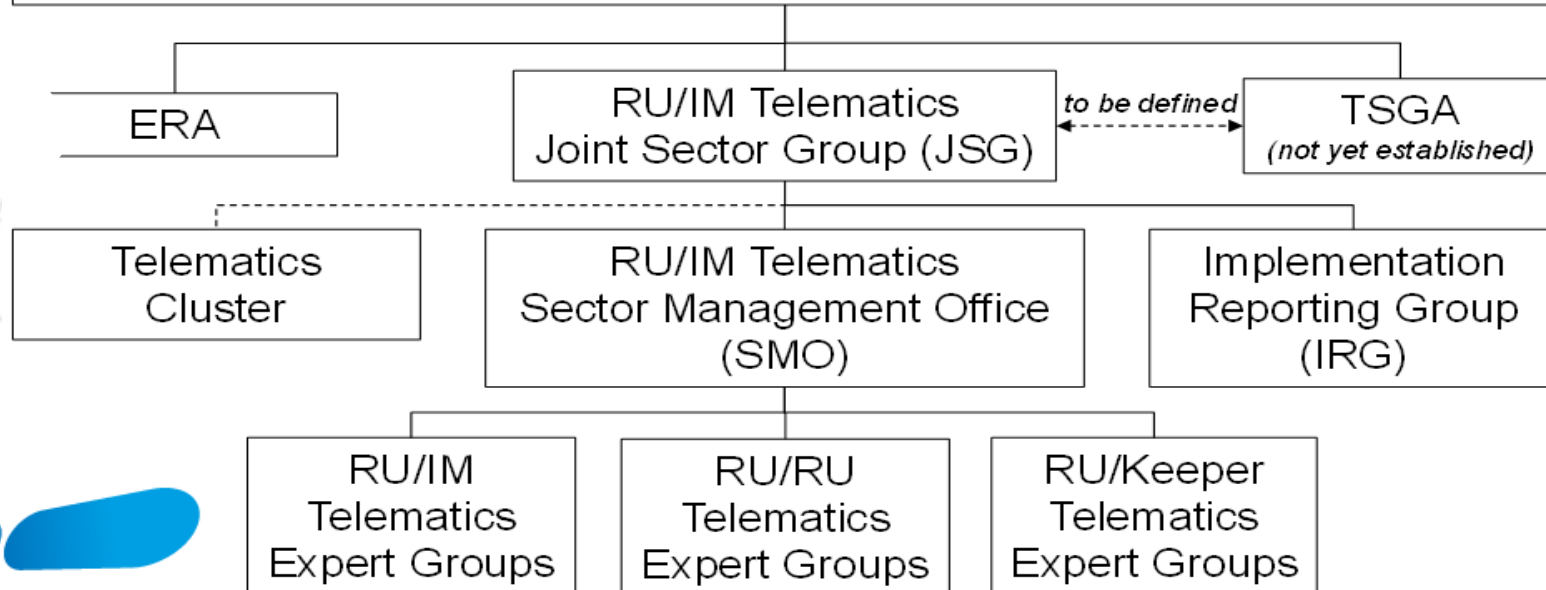

## Common Interface available at company level

## Implementation of «Short Term Path Request»



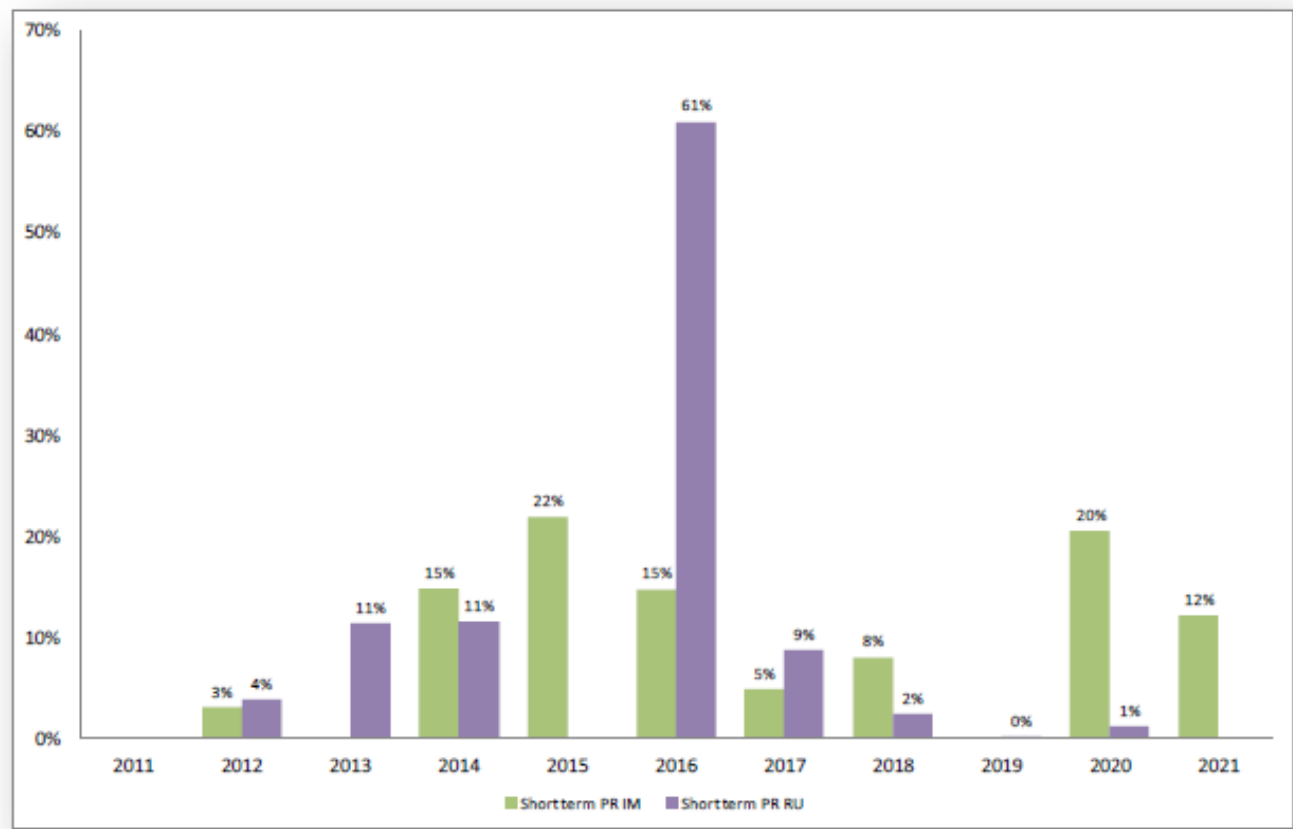
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## State of play

With regard to the Common Masterplan the exchange of TSI TAF messages for “Short Term Path Request” should have started as early as 2012 with a target implementation date of 2017 and a full implementation to be expected by 2021.

Several IM and RU have indicated that implementation might be delayed due to open questions.



- What is TAF/TAP compliant? Manual/Automatic/CI-Interface?
- What is „Short Term“?
- Which timetable period is affected (annual, late, ad-hoc, operational)?
- When are the CRD (locations) fully in use?
- Which message is implemented by when?
- Big bang or step-by-step implementation (P/F)?
- Does the development of PCS affect the TAF/TAP implementation?
- Does the RNE/FTE project „TT-Redesign“ influences the TAF/TAP?
- Is there a common agreed T-ID/P-ID migration plan?
- Financing and sponsors?
- RFC requirements?
- ...



- On March 17th, 2016 the TAF JSG has decided that a common approach shall be worked out in order to support a smooth implementation of the „Path request“ functions in TSI TAF. It was decided to establish a short questionnaire to be sent out with the 4th TAF reporting period
- On April 13th, 2016 the Telematic Expert Group „Planning“ has supported this common approach
- The IRG will work out the questionnaire together with CER, ERA and RNE
- The questionnaire will be sent out the IM and RU contact persons in June 2016
- Feedback will be analyzed and further actions will be discussed (e.g. TAF/TAP Path Request Common-Roll-Out-Plan)
