RAG

- Regulation 913/2010: « The Management board shall set up a further advisory group made up of railway undertakings interested in the use of the freight corridor »
- Proposal of the Management board: invite active* applicants - on the corridor - to RAG meetings

* **Active** applicant: an applicant which has already made PaP requests (as of today, two of such applicants are concerned)
