TSI OPE workshop

Consultation input asked by EC, DG MOVE

- The EC would like to make an exhaustive list of operational issues that are considered and that should be tackled on the corridors for quick-wins results on the performance of the international traffic, in order to present them in detailed with the TSI OPE working party (TSI OPE WP).
- The aim of the EC, DG MOVE, is to:
 - better understand each other's mandate, "boundaries of action" and objectives.
 - Identify the issues: which ones concern the TSI OPE WP? Which one the RFCs? Which ones both parties... with possible diverging interests / proposed solutions?
 - Who does what, how and by when? Some specific issues might need to be treated iteratively: Firstly the RFCs look for quick fixes, possibly within a limited area; and Secondly TSI OPE WP looks for possible harmonisation, when relevant.
- The TSI OPE WG is inviting the Managing Directors of the Corridors. For the purpose of the technical discussion each RFC can be accompanied by an expert or by a NSA from the RFC.
