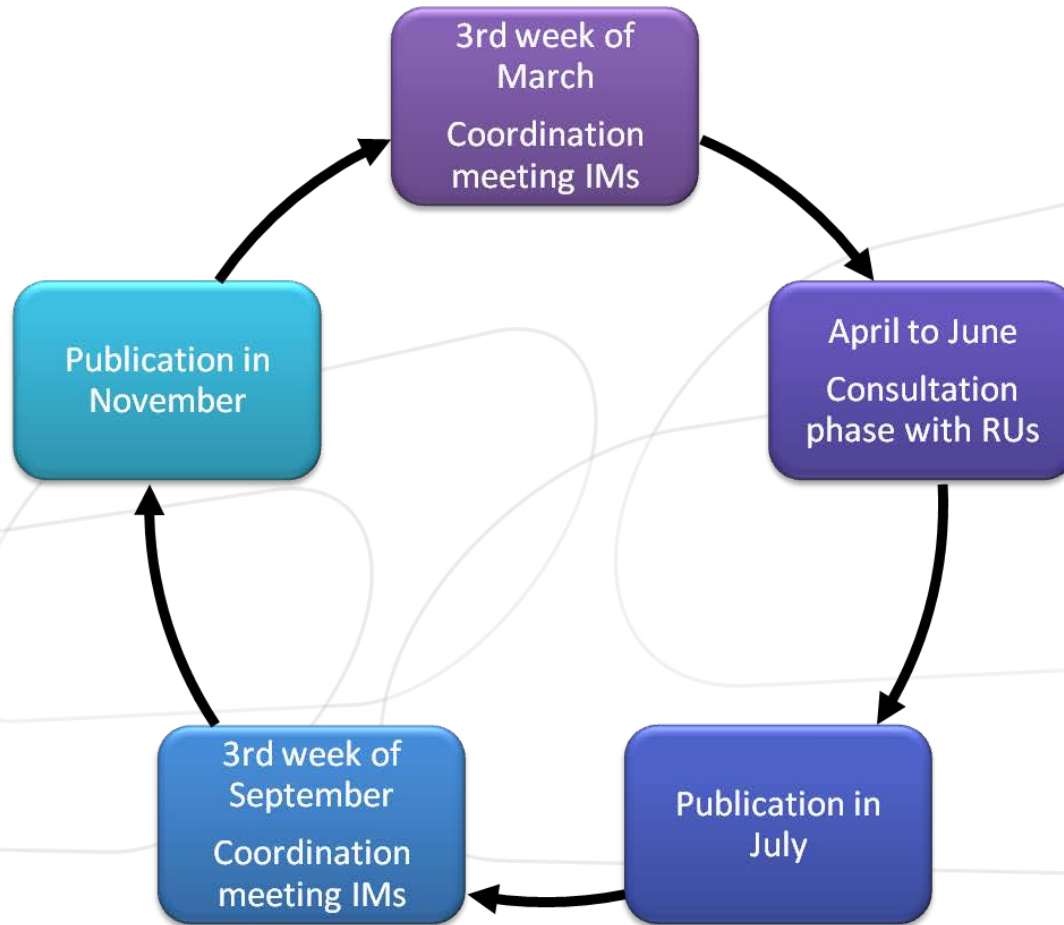

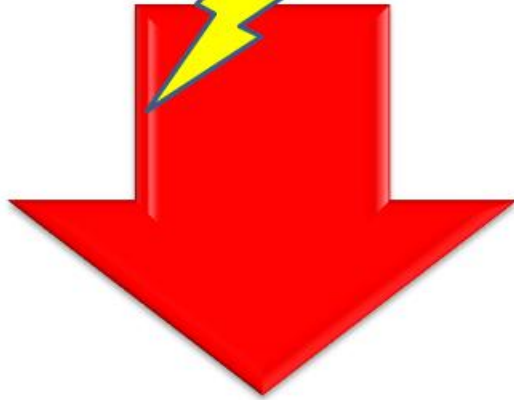
# Coordination of works on Corridor 2

  - Pétange to Bettembourg via Esch and Pétange to Bettembourg via Luxembourg
  - MsM-Longuyon and Zoufftgen-Thionville
  - Longuyon-Thionville and Conflans Jarny – Hagondange
  - Metz – Réding via Rémillly and Metz-Réding via Frouard
  - Belgium – Paris via Tergnier and Belgium – Paris via Creil
  - Namur – Luxembourg via Kleinbettingen and Namur – Luxembourg via Aubange

# Not all paths are reliable

- Pre-arranged Paths should not be affected

BUT...

- All international paths are not PaPs
- When an Applicant books a PaP, he/she can also ask for feeder / outflow paths. These feeder / outflow paths are not PaPs and then could be affected by works that have been re-planned on a late-time schedule by an IM.

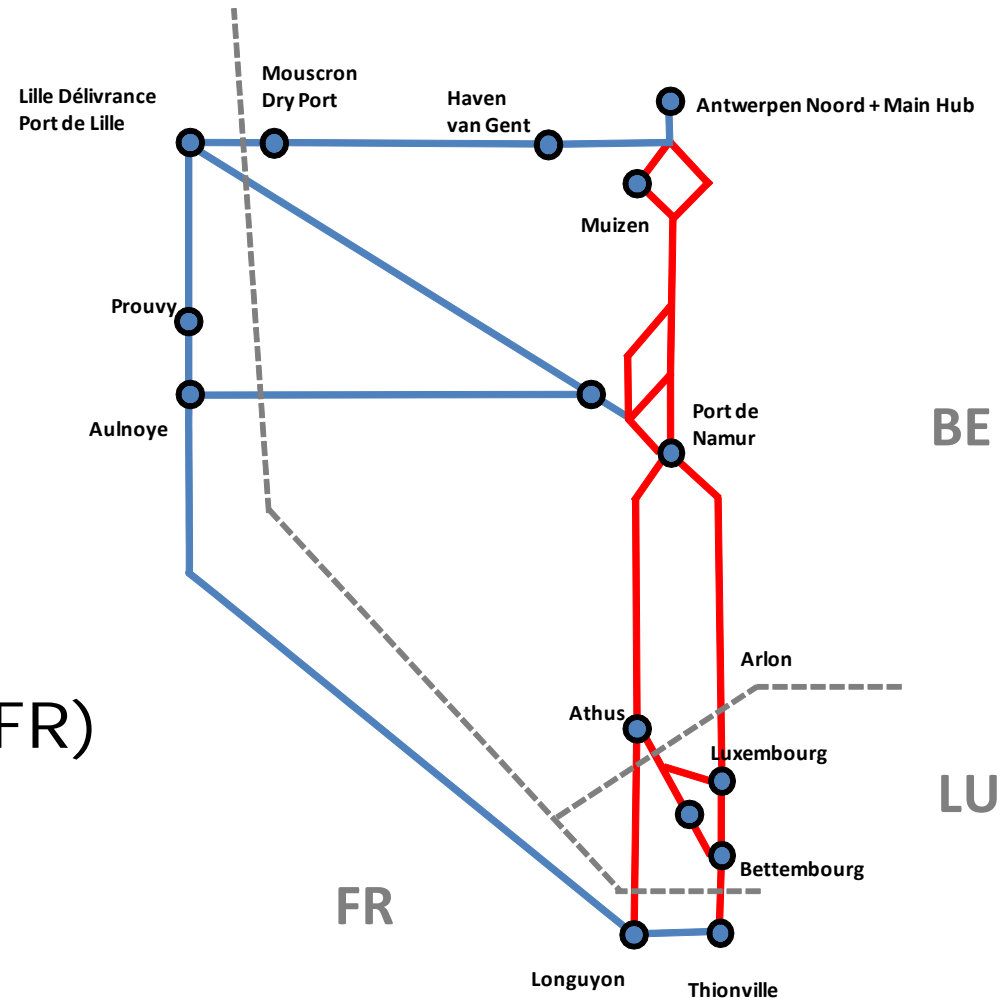
