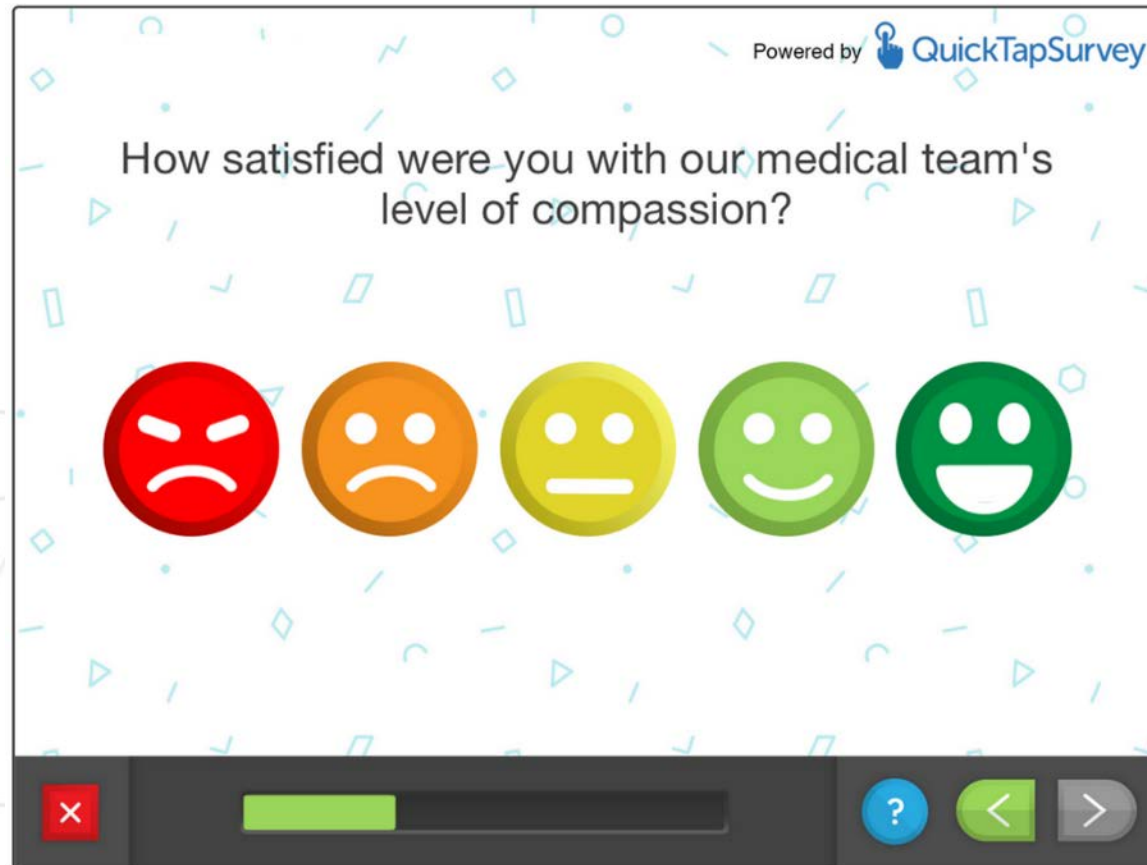

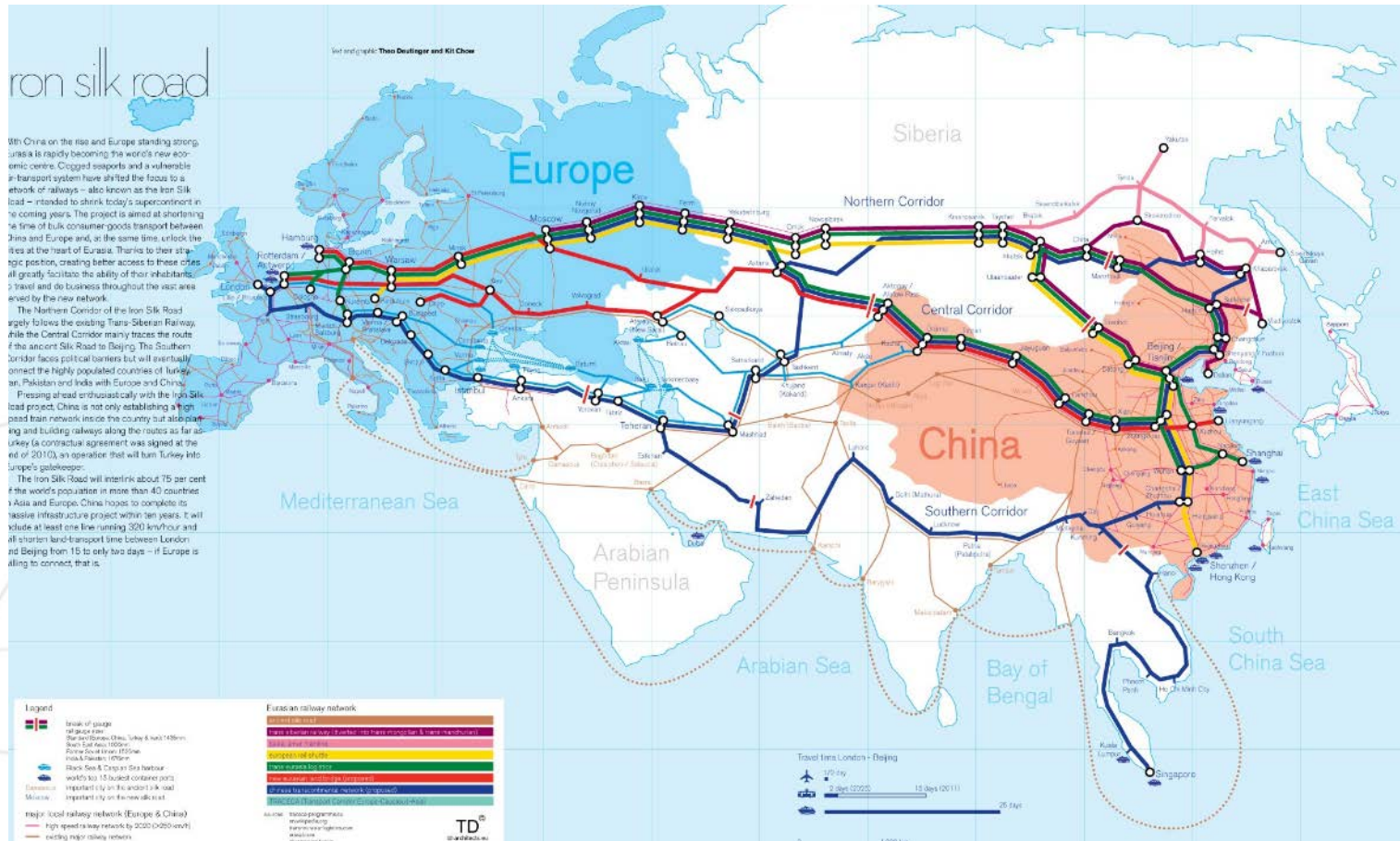

## Info & Study Trip Rail Freight Corridor 2



### Overview

Rail Freight Corridor 2 (RFC 2) from Antwerp/Zeebrugge and Rotterdam to Basel/Lyon plays a major role when it comes to the shift of goods from road to rail: In 2017 it allocated 7.1 million kilometers-day to railway companies. This helps the rail freight traffic to constantly rise in the corridor. For 2016, again a significant rise was measured (+14% compared to 2013).

On 7 July 2017 Europe's largest intermodal inland terminal at Dudelange in Luxembourg was inaugurated. It is built to accommodate up to 600'000 units per year – half of them with horizontal and half with vertical handling. It will add a strong contribution to the shift of goods from road to rail in an important catchment area with many production facilities.

The trip took place from 20-22 September 2017. The kick-off at Basel was attended by over 30 media representatives and opinion leaders. **Programme details can be found here.**
