Why working on-time departure ?


A train that starts its journey late is unlikely to arrive on time...

• The pre-running period is of the utmost importance to ensure that the departure is on time.

 It is very effective to put the emphasis on respecting departure times. For local staffs this allows them to monitor <u>their</u> action regarding the punctuality & quality of service unlike the « global » data.



- Evaluation of the resiliency of the transport plan


